Domestic Violence / Trauma Therapy

DV/Trauma often causes or triggers alcohol/drug use. We help residential and outpatient clients become aware of these issues and start their healing process.

Family Therapy

ACW's therapists work with residential & outpatient clients to improve family communication & build bridges often broken due to addiction.

Nutrition Counseling

ACW's nutritionist helps clients achieve better health through nutrition & cooking classes, residential menu prep and one-on-one consultations.

Case Management

We link clients with medical & mental health providers, courts, probation, parole, the department of child & family services to promote whole person care.

Transportation

ACW offers supervised transportation to medical, mental health & other essential appointments.

Our Programs

Residential

A safe, structured, 24/7 alcohol and drug treatment program that is CARF-accredited. Clients receive treatment in a home-like environment focusing on wellness, where they learn skills that encourage long-term recovery.

Groups include: *Women and Addiction, Anger Management, Seeking Safety, Culture and Addiction, MRT, Art Therapy, Parenting, Relapse Prevention, Addiction and DV, Living Skills, Grief and Loss.*



Outpatient

Our Outpatient programs are CARF-accredited and offered in English and Spanish during the day and evening to accommodate family and/or work responsibilities.

Groups include: *Women and Addiction, Anger Management, Seeking Safety, Culture and Addiction, MRT, Parenting, Relapse Prevention, Addiction and DV, Living Skills, Grief and Loss.*



Intensive Outpatient Treatment

At least 9 hours per week of group and individual treatment.



Outpatient Counseling

At least 3 hours per week of group and individual treatment.



Recovery Support Services

Up to 7 hours per month of services.



Enhanced Care Management

Service coordination and referrals for those who are homeless, leaving jail/prison, in need of mental health or substance abuse treatment or frequently use emergency rooms or hospitals.
