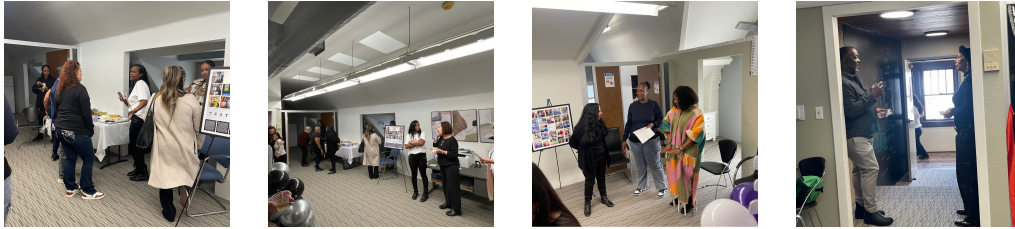
Open House & Ribbon Cutting ECM Headquarters

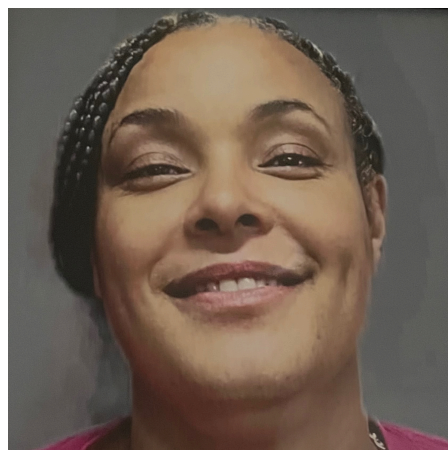



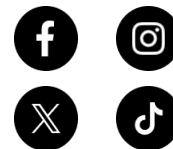
